EXHIBITOR REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES

Thank you for your interest in participating in the Florida Flywheelers Antique Engine Club's Shows. We are sorry, but we are unable to accept reservations over the phone or the internet. We are all volunteers and cannot be available at all times.

The procedure to obtain an Exhibitor site is to **show up in person** starting on the Saturday before the show starts, we are open 8:00 am to 6:00 pm **each day** until the show starts, then during the show we are open, 7:00 am to 9:00 am and 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm. The available sites are available on a first come, first served basis.

For the following show, you may reserve the same site(s) you are on. To reserve the site(s) **you are on only, you must pay for the site(s) on Saturday, the last day of the show between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm.** If you wish to change sites, you must show up as if you are starting over, as described in the paragraph above. Again, first come, first served.

An Exhibit consists of antique engines, tractors, cars, or other related equipment. To Qualify as an Exhibitor, the Club rules specify that 50% of each site must be covered by the Exhibit. The sites are 25 ft. frontage on the aisle and 20 ft. deep. The Exhibit must **not** be for sale. Exhibitors are not allowed to sell at all. We request you Exhibit all 4 days of the show, Wednesday through Saturday. The public is paying to come in to see exhibits all 4 Days.

Exhibitors must be members. We do charge a maintenance fee of \$25.00 per exhibit. We supply limited electric, on most sites. **The electric is not enough to run RV air conditioners, coffee pots or heaters.** Depending upon your arrival date, we cannot guarantee electric sites will be available.

Also please note, during the show days, no vehicle traffic is permitted on the show grounds, between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm. The safety of our patrons is very important to us. Vehicles cannot move until after 4:00 pm during show days.
